Labor principles proposed for Grupo SURA and its strategic investments

In keeping with our commitment to the Declaration of the International Labor Organization – ILO –, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and the United Nations Global Pact, we hereby declare the following labor principles as a contribution to human development and quality of life.

The application of these principles extends to Grupo SURA and its strategic investments. In addition, they constitute a guide to analyze new investments and to develop new businesses:

- 1. We respect human dignity, without discrimination on race, religion, gender, functionality, sexual orientation or political grounds.
- 2. We act in strict compliance with the law and the regulations, and we contribute to the creation of fair and equitable societies.
- 3. We condemn forced labor, child labor, or any other form of labor that violates human decorum and dignity.
- 4. We encourage good treatment, and we act with respect, responsibility, a quantity and transparency in our relationships.
- 5. We promote open dialogue, based on fear of expression and on timely, clear, ample and sufficient information.
- 6. We support and respect the protection of human rights and we make sure that we are not accomplices in violations of those rights in our labor and business relations.
- 7. We guarantee a dignified remuneration, according to the results of the company, the industry, and the local labor market.
- 8. We work towards the personal and professional development of our employees is a guarantee for the long-term continuity of the business.
- 9. We respect freedom of Association and recognized the right to collective bargaining.
- 10. We encourage security, health, and well-being in the workplace.
